Sermon Summary

This message explores the meaning of Jesus as our Everlasting Father (Isaiah 9:6), highlighting God's enduring presence, steadfast love, and faithful care for His people. Unlike earthly relationships that can fail or fade, God's fatherhood is constant—marked by provision, discipline, protection, and intimacy that never runs out.

Discussion Questions

1. When you hear the phrase “Everlasting Father,” what thoughts or emotions come to mind? How does this description of God challenge or affirm your current view of Him?
2. In what ways can our experiences with earthly fathers shape how we relate to God—for better or worse?
3. Isaiah 9:6 connects God’s fatherhood with eternity. Why do you think it matters that God’s care and authority never end?
4. Where in your life do you struggle to trust that God is both loving and present over the long haul?
5. What is one practical way you can live this week in response to God being your Everlasting Father?
